


Joshua Harr Shane



Joshua's dream was to become a Doctor like Patch Adams. Thanks to our partnership with Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, Hamilton, the Foundation is pleased to announce Joshua is three steps closer to that dream. In 2016, the Joshua Harr Shane Patient Rehabilitation Room for Physical Therapy and the Joshua Harr Shane Stroke Gym were dedicated. Now, in 2018, the Joshua Harr Shane PET/CT Scan Suite will open.

Through the continued partnership between The Joshua Harr Shane Foundation and the hospital, Joshua continues to touch the lives of each and every person who visits his therapy rooms.

We intend to continue supporting Joshua's dream going forward. Just last year we helped a patient, who had used Joshua's Stroke Gym, purchase a Bioness unit. This is a medical device used to help him regain the use of his hand after suffering a stroke. This equipment was not covered by insurance.

Joshua's dream was to become a doctor. Through these therapy rooms he will be able to touch all who pass through them for healing. We wanted to stay connected to those patients who may require additional help.

We were contacted by the therapist below to help purchase a Bioness H200 which was not covered by insurance. The patient was 35 and recovering from a stroke. #SeasonOfSmiles

The Bioness Ness H200 is a wireless hand rehabilitation system which supports the wrist in a functioning position, allowing the fingers and thumb to move efficiently while performing daily functional tasks such as reaching, grasping and pinching. This device will increase Peter's ability to regain the functional use of his left hand; which he lost after suffering a stroke in 2016. THE GIFT OF HEARING

Exactly two years ago today I was on a flight from Los Angeles to Pittsburgh after a wonderful winter holiday vacation. On the descent of the plane my ears popped so severely that it caused me to have sudden onset hearing loss in both ears. I was just entering my spring semester at college and my hearing loss made it more and more difficult and frustrating to understand my teachers and classmates. My parents and friends kept telling me to go to the doctors, but I was convinced that it was a short term situation and that my hearing would come back any day. After weeks with no progress and growing frustration. I finally went to an audiologist in Pittsburgh. After several tests it was determined that I had lost most all of the hearing capability in my right ear and about half in my left. Doctors couldn't determine the exact reason for the sudden loss and did not know if it would come back.

After months and months of doctors appointments, cat scans, MR/s, and hearing tests. I finally came to terms with the loss and started trying to find ways to make- do with the hearing I had. I began teaching myself sign language and learning how to read lips, but that could only do so much. I was still unable to hear in general and struggled in class and in social situations.

My entire family started to search for alternatives to bring back even a small fraction of my hearing back. One of my mother's friends suggested we contact Dr. Tara Fuchs, a wonderful audiologist in New Jersey, my home state. Dr. Fuchs led us to the Joshua Harr Shane Foundation, an organization that follows Joshua Harr Shane's passion for helping people and giving them what they need to live happily even with their illnesses.

As we celebrate the New Year of 2017, I would like to give a special thanks to the Joshua Harr Shane Foundation. The organization found out about my sudden loss and provided me with the gift of hearing. They gifted me with Phonak hearing aids for both ears along with a ComPilot to adjust volume and settings. I could not be more grateful for the gift that this organization presented to me. I can now hear at work, in class, and in social situations. My loss has also caused the teachers in my BFA program at Carnegie Mellon University to become more aware of working with those who are hearing disabled. They have been very accommodating and are learning with me about different devices and teaching methods that work in my situation. It is because of the gift of my hearing aids that I am able to communicate properly with the world around me. I cannot thank Joshua Harr Shane and this foundation enough for the gift of hearing.

The Beginning

The Joshua Harr Shane Foundation was founded in 2000 and has provided the opportunity for the legacy of Joshua Harr Shane to live on in the lives of those he loved, those whom loved him, and now those who have had a chance to be touched by the Joshua Harr Shane Foundation. The foundation was set up to honor Joshua. He embodied those traits that illustrate the very best of our young citizens, the future of our nation.

The foundation has helped New Jersey families spanning the state including residents of Essex, Mercer, Union, Hunterdon, Middlesex, Ocean, Atlantic, Cape May, Monmouth counties.

Additionally, the foundation has provided life-saving emergency care for infants at Boston Children's Hospital, helping to pay for their extended stays while their children were undergoing medical treatment. And it doesn't stop there, the foundation also supports families at Philadelphia Children's Hospital and the Shriner's Hospital.

Since September 11, 2001, the foundation has provided ongoing charitable support to our military service men and women and their families. The Joshua Harr Shane Foundations supports special needs children, donates toys to sick children in various hospitals and helps pay for medical care and monetary assistance to families in need of assistance due to an ill family member. Additionally, the foundation donates phone cards to the United States troops via Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst so that they can phone home for the holidays.

"In 2016, we began to support our military even more locally by giving out gift certificates for lunch at the Columbus Flea Market as a 'thank you' to our soldiers and veterans for their incredible service and self-sacrificing spirit to make a difference," Mrs. Shane said.

Over the years JHSF has shipped assorted sports equipment, snacks, toiletries, DVDs, CDs, phone cards, puzzles, American flags, and anything else they could think of that would help brighten someone's day. Some of these items are donated, some are purchased by JHSF.

All items are shipped by JHSF. They have donated tickets to area events in hopes of creating lasting memories for our military families.

More than \$10,000 worth of supplies has been donated, collected, sent, and delivered to hurricane victims in Texas by the foundation. More than \$2,500 in supplies has been sent to Puerto Rico. In 2017, the Joshua Harr Shane Foundation also sent toys to the children of the Florida Keys who had lost so much following a natural disaster devastating the region. The foundation fulfilled every child's request for a specific toy and ensured they received it by the holidays.

The Joshua Harr Shane Foundation has worked with the Embrace Kids Foundation, donates annual scholarships to Hightstown High School, Beth El Synagogue, and in the past to Rutgers University and St. Anthony's of Padua Parish. JHSF helps bring smiles and dreams to children at Better Beginnings of Hightstown, a nonprofit daycare.

"Joshua's dream was to become a doctor. He always helped people in need, from strangers to friends, and stood up for what he thought was right as a natural leader who made a difference," Mrs. Shane said. "It is because of you — #JoshLives!"
